"72 percent of the people interviewed said they think the church is full of hypocrites"

"A majority of unchurched Americans (79 percent) think that Christianity today is more about organized religion than about loving God and loving people; 86 percent believe they can have a good relationship with God without being involved in church."

"These outsiders are making a clear comment that churches are not getting through on the two greatest commandments, 'to love God and love your neighbor'

"71 percent of the respondents said they believe Jesus 'makes a positive difference in a person's life' and 78 percent said they would 'be willing to listen' to someone who wanted to share what they believed about Christianity."

"We think religion is a topic that is off-limits in polite conversation, but unchurched people say they would enjoy conversations about spiritual matters"

"Other findings showed that 44 percent said Christians "get on my nerves."
