Take heart: to gain courage or confidence; to begin to feel better and more hopeful

One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek him in his temple. For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling; he will hide me in the shelter of his sacred tent and set me high upon a rock.

Hear my voice when I call, Lord; be merciful to me and answer me. My heart says of you, "Seek his face!" Your face, Lord, I will seek. Do not hide your face from me, do not turn your servant away in anger; you have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, God my Savior.

26 & 27-Reconciled with the Father

Vs. 29-31-They still don't get it. "Do you now believe?"

-It's not that God is keeping things from us like a mean big brother.

-It's we are finite. We don't understand, nor can we. We see dimly.

For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I have been fully known.

-We live in a sinful and broken world. One day, we will not. Death will be no more. In the meantime...

So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is love. 1 Corinthians 13:12-13

-But why? Why is life so hard? We are here in a broken world holding the only hope for brokenness.
