-Today is the prequel to Epistle of Paul to the church in Philippi, known by most as Philippians.

Why "JOY in Context"?

- -There is a CONTEXT about this letter that I think will help us have true biblical JOY. More on that NEXT WEEK, but FIRST... The Prequel.
 - Memes are short, usually funny videos. There's a popular one out there that quotes a song by Tay Money (Which I DO NOT recommend) and says "I understood the assignment"

What's your assignment?

- Saved *from* sin *to* Body of Christ, given a gift *FOR* the mutual exhoration, edification, and or encouragement of the church.
- What's yours? Our gifts will vary, but when our gifts are used *FOR* the Kingdom of God, it always works out.

Jesus says it this way...

The Apostle Paul is a great example of such living!

- "Kingdom First mindset" and even when things seemingly don't work out, they do work out in the big picture.
