How can you know you have eternal life? It's like this. Likely the author, the Apostle John, writes in this letter to the Church, "it's like this." "It's like what?", you may ask. "It's like Jesus"

whoever says he abides in him ought to walk in the same way in which he walked.1 John 2:6

-Direction, not perfection.

Anchors, or tethers this WALK to 2 truths about God

God is Light 1:5 / God is Love 1 John 4:8 & 16

These are the foundation to 4 steps in what it looks like to "walk like Jesus". **Joy-** And we are writing these things so that our joy may be complete. 1:4 **Holiness-** I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. 2:1

Truth- I write these things to you about those who are trying to deceive you. 2:26 **Assurance-** I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life. 5:13

They are not linear but circular (Slinky), working together to a life well lived to the glory of God and your joy!

Read Vs. 26

"I write these things to you" What things? The whole letter. He writes to establish the church family in TRUTH.

"About those who are trying to deceive you"

The word "deceive" is used 4x's in this letter.

But... you

In contrast to "those", John, in usual fashion in the letter, speaks Gospel truth to the believer. The "you" is in the emphatic form of Greek, setting it apart from others. It would be like saying "I write these things to you about those who are trying to deceive you. But the anointing that **YOU!** received from him abides in you." The emphasis promotes distinction, thus in keeping with the structure of the letter, let's

follow the redeemed patterns of the letter and look at who YOU are in contrast to *"those"* (see above).

YOU 6x

1:3 that which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that YOU too may have fellowship with us; and indeed our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son Jesus Christ.

YOU too may have Fellowship-> God is light, therefore we walk in light. When we do not, we are offered the gift of repentance & have an advocate, Jesus who is the propitiation for our sin and faithfully forgives and cleanses us. The love of God is perfected, or made whole, in us. We are forgiven, intimately know God, we have overcome the evil one, we are strong & God's word abides in us.

2:20, But YOU have been anointed by the Holy One, and you all have knowledge

You know truth and have a teacher, the Holy Spirit who illuminates the Word of God teaching us to live like Jesus-> The Jesus life is the best life (Direction, not perfect)

2:24, Let what YOU heard from the beginning abide in you. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, then YOU too will abide in the Son and in the Father.

What YOU heard, remain. Then YOU too will remain (abide) with God. Be assured of your eternal life; it's a promise

2:27, But the anointing that YOU received from him abides in you, and you have no need that anyone should teach you. But as his anointing teaches you about everything, and is true, and is no lie–just as it has taught you, abide in him.

Anointing-It's interesting to note that the author does not simply say "Spirit" (Pneuma). 4 - 7 He introduces the Spirit in 3:24 and again in 4:2, 4:6, 4:13.

It begs the question then, what is the anointing? Most scholars agree it speaks of the Holy Spirit, but is tied to verse 24, working together as the Word and the Spirit.

Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you. If what you heard from the beginning abides in you, then you too will abide in the Son and in the Father.

The word *received (see Greek) means "to take" or "put on as his own" Reminds me of ICLV, "Take it", which also reminds me of Oprah, "You get a car, and you get a car"

The difference is this text says we receive the "anointing" from Him <mark>(Jesus, the Messiah which literally means, the anointed one)</mark>

Abides in you

The word abides means "shall remain". In direct contrast to "those", YOU SHALL REMAIN!

The connection between the anointing the believers have received and the abiding nature of the message (v. 24) they have heard is brought to the forefront of this discussion so that they will understand that both of these abide in them and both of these will fortify them in their battle against the heretics. Vs. 26- The 3rd "main Idea" in 1 John-> Truth

-**"I write these things…"** Joy(<mark>1:4</mark>), Holiness(<mark>2:1</mark>), Truth(<mark>2:26</mark>) & Assurance(<mark>5:13</mark>).

The context would seem to indicate that "these things" would refer to the previous verses, 2:15-19 & 22. BUT, the since the entire structure of the letter is like a slinky and continues to circle back to themes throughout, it's likely *these things* are throughout the letter.

Deceive is used 4 times in 1 John (1:8, 2:26, 3:7, 4:6-> We are from God. Whoever knows God listens to us; whoever is not from God does not listen to us. By this we
 know the Spirit of truth and the spirit of error.³)

*Those-*John is identifying who he is speaking of. Who are they? The focus of the *"those "* in 2:26 is fallen, thus following the sin patterns in 1 John, lets define them.

If we say 1:6, 1:8, 1:10 Chapter 1 keeps the personal pronouns to "we" and these 3 verses are the only use of the word "we" in a fallen condition, which is notable since it's used 83 times. 3 used to possibly describe people in our church who are not saved, and <u>80x's used to describe what the redeemed life looks like!</u>

32 - 34 Chapter 2 expands to *anyone* and is a mixture of positive, 2:1b, 5:16a neutral, 2:27 &
 35 - 38 negative, 2:15, 3:17, 4:8, 4:20.

"whoever" begins in Ch. 2 as well as is used 25x's in 1 John. It's often used as a contrast between negatives and positives (ex. 2:4-6). For this study, I will list only the fallen uses. 2:4, 2:9, 2:11,3:8, 3:10, 3:14b, 4:6b, 4:18b, 5:10, 5:12b, "they/those" 2:19, 51-59
2:26, 4:5 "everyone" 3:4, 3:15 "who" 2:22, 3:6, 3:10, 3:12, 3:20

Anointing-It's interesting to note that the author does not simply say "Spirit" (Pneuma). He introduces the Spirit in 3:24 and again in 4:2, 4:6, 4:13.

It begs the question then, what is the anointing? Most scholars agree it speaks of the Holy Spirit, but is tied to verse 24, working together as the Word and the Spirit. (See commentary below).

The word *received (see Greek) means "to take" or "put on as his own"

Reminds me of ICLV, "Take it", which also reminds me of Oprah, "You get a car, and you get a car"

The difference is this text says we receive the "anointing" from Him <mark>(Jesus, the Messiah which literally means, the anointed one)</mark>

Abides in you

The word abides means "shall remain". In direct contrast to "those", YOU SHALL REMAIN!

Commentary

Anointing=Spirit

He exhorts them to continue to stand strong in the faith by drawing upon the strength
that is theirs through reception of the Spirit of God (the anointing), first mentioned in v.
20. The connection between the anointing the believers have received and the
abiding nature of the message (v. 24) they have heard is brought to the forefront of
this discussion so that they will understand that both of these abide in them and both
of these will fortify them in their battle against the heretics. This connection would lend
support to the idea that the abiding chrisma encompasses both the Spirit of God and
the word of God.⁶

The anointing of Christ ($\tau \dot{o} \chi \rho i \sigma \mu \alpha \ \alpha \dot{v} \tau \sigma \hat{v}$) abides with them as a permanent gift, and renders further apostolic teaching unnecessary. It is quite a mistake to suppose that the superfluous teaching refers to the antichrists. The ideal to which the Christian must aspire is the being led into all truth by the Spirit; he will need no human teachers then (see the remarkable parallel to this in Jer. 31:33, and the quotation of it in Heb. 8:10, 11).⁷

No need for Teaching?

This linkage of the Spirit and the word helps one to make sense of the difficult phrase that follows. It seems odd that John, given the didactic nature of this epistle, would say to the community that "you do not need anyone to teach you." John is not denying the importance and place of human teachers. The mere fact that he wrote this letter is sufficient proof. This claim that they have no need of someone to teach them echoes the promises that Jesus made in the Gospel that the Paraclete would lead them into all truth (John 14:16-17, 26; 16:13). The ministry of the Spirit worked through the apostles (not the heretics) to bring the message of salvation that is found in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God. Here was the reliable truth they were taught. Additional revelation was not needed; indeed it could be deadly. Spiritual illumination of the received traditions was the pattern they should follow. In addition, it is the fulfillment of the promise of the new covenant in which all the members of the

community are taught by God (John 6:45) and no one needs to be taught by his neighbor, for the law of God will be written on their hearts, and they will know God. One other comment about this part of the verse should also be noted. It is also possible that John is making this declaration in an extreme form to give intensity to his statements about the power that is available to the believer through the anointing. This statement also serves the purpose of keeping the members of the community away from the deceivers who claimed to be teaching new truths about God.⁸

To mislead people as to proper views which they should have may often be expressed idiomatically, for example, 'to twist people's thoughts,' 'to cause what is false to seem like what is true,' 'to make a lie appear true,' 'to dig away the truth,' or 'to cover the eyes with lies.'¹⁰

The Classical and Hellenistic Use- πλανάω means "to lead astray," πλανάομαι "to go astray," πλάνη and πλάνος "going astray," πλανήτης and πλάνης "one who leads astray," all at first in a topographical sense... Argos causes to wander.

In the non-geographical sense the word group denotes vacillation and then absence of goal in the field of knowledge, speech and action.

In the Septuagint-the group is used generally for transgression of the revealed will of God and more specifically for instigation to idolatry.

The expression in Mt. disengages nλανᾶσθαι from a purely literal sense. More strongly than in the LXX version (→ 235, 3 ff.), the straying is culpable here. It is no longer a pitiable state. Straying and returning are parallel to ἀμαρτίαι (sin) and δικαιοσύνη (justification) in 1 Pt. 2:24.

84 In Eph. 4:14 πλάνη is related in a new way to the Christ event. Its opposite is growth into Christ as the head of the body, or the growth of the whole body into Him. This comes about through the pursuit of truth (i.e., true faith) in love. Error, on the other hand, is marked by craftiness, at which men insidiously aim, and by fickleness, against which Christians must be urgently warned.

It is not surprising to find a dualistic background for the use of the word group in 1 85 86 John. Deception and error are not of the truth (1:8; 4:6). They take place in the sphere 87 - 91 of truth and lies (2:21f., 27), of light and darkness (1:5-7; 2:11), of life and death (3:14), 92 and do not belong intrinsically to the community (2:19). Error is the opposite of true 93 94 divine reality. The deceivers or false teachers (2:26; 3:7) and the Christians who echo 95 their words (1:8) either dispute the presence of sin in the Christian and the need for a life in forgiveness or in antinomian (anti-law or lawless) fashion they make light of the 96 significance of the work of righteousness and sin nature for the Christian (3:7). This practical reference is not abandoned even when the group is centrally linked to 97 98 Christology, i.e., when the false teachers deny that Jesus is the Christ (2:22, 26) or 99 when the spirit of error or the seducers ($n\lambda \dot{a}$ voi 2 Jn. 7) oppose docetically¹¹ the

The test proposed for these false teachers, listening to the preaching of the 104 ... community (4:6) and the abiding of the traditional proclamation in Christians (2:24), brings out in both instances the ultimately practical character of the error. This deception ($\pi\lambda\alpha\nu\hat{\alpha}\nu$) is practiced by men (2:26; 3:7); indeed, it may be directed by 106 ---Christians against themselves (1:8). But these false teachers are metaphysical figures; 108 109 ... antichrists (ἀντίχριστοι), 2:18; spirit of antichrist, 2 Jn. 7). Mk. 8:38 and par.) that when Jesus looked ahead to the end of the days He not merely claimed for Himself the office of Judge of the world (→ υἱός, ὁ υἱὸς τοῦ ἀνθρώπου) but was also conscious of being the defender of those who confess Him (and the accuser of those who deny Him) at the judgment seat of the Father. The Christian concept of a transcendent eschatological Paraclete, traces of which may be found throughout the NT,92 goes back to Jesus. 2. More richly developed if more difficult to define is the idea, expressly attested only in Jn., of a Paraclete at work in the world both in and for the disciples.93 Jesus Himself is regarded as

Anoint; to assign a person to a task, with the implication of supernatural sanctions, blessing, and endowment[–]'to anoint, to assign, to appoint, assignment, appointment.'¹⁴

When the community is assaulted by antichrists it can resist only in the power of the Spirit, the anointing ($\chi\rho$ î $\sigma\mu\sigma$, 2:20, 27). The use of this term, which means "anointing oil," implies that the community is anointed with the Spirit, this being the basis of the fact that it belongs to Christ. The anointing (χρίσμα) imparts to the community its comprehensive knowledge-"All Knowledge" (οἴδατε πάντα (2:20))-which confers on it the clarity of faith and judgment and the assurance in life and decision that come from its relationship to God. This statement about the anointing (χρῖσμα) of the community is directly connected with what Christ says about the paraclete παράκλητος in Jn. 16:8-10, 13 f. The community has received the χρίσμα as a power 126 which remains in it and gives it comprehensive and reliable instruction, 2:27.15 A notable feature in the ecclesiastical situation in which the Johannine Epistles were written is that the author does not refer the community to an authoritative teaching office but reminds it of its reception of the xpiqua which is itself the teacher and which makes the community independent of a teaching office: $\tau \dot{\mathbf{o}} \circ \dot{\mathbf{u}} \tau \circ \hat{\mathbf{0}}$ χρισμα 128 διδάσκει ὑμâς περὶ πἀντων, 2:27. This shows how strongly in John the understanding of the Messiah is determined by the anointing of the Spirit and how the relation between the Son and sons, which is based on reception of the Spirit, finds an echo in the connection between the anointed One and the anointed.¹⁶

Receive; to acquire possession of something–'to take, to acquire, to obtain.'19 καὶ τῷ θἑλοντί σοι κριθῆναι καὶ τὸν χιτῶνὰ σου λαβεῖν, ἄφες αὐτῷ καὶ τὸ ἰμἀτιον 'if anyone wants to sue you in court to take your shirt, let him have your coat as well' Mt 5:40. In some languages 'take' in Mt 5:40 may be best rendered as 'go away with' or 'put it on as his own.'¹⁷

such during His earthly ministry (14:16).94 The only description, however, is that of the ἄλλος παράκλητος who after the departure of Jesus will continue His work and remain for ever with and in the disciples (14:16f., 26; 16:7, 13f.). This is the Spirit (→ πνεῦμα).95 Sent by God or Jesus to the disciples (14:16, 26; 15:26; 16:7)-not to the world, which has no organ for Him (14:17)-He teaches with all-embracing authority and yet with strict adherence to Jesus and His message, maintaining, expanding and completing the work of Jesus, leading the disciples into all truth (14:26; 15:26; 16:13f.). His witness to Jesus (15:26),96 however, is also an accusation of the world before God's judgment seat: He convicts the world in respect of sin, righteousness and judgment. That is, He shows that sin is on the side of the world, right and triumph on that of Jesus (16:8-11).97 The puzzle of the combination of kerygmatic and forensic features in the picture of the Spirit-Paraclete98 is solved if we trace back the tradition historically to the OT and Jewish idea of the advocate (→ 809, 12-810, 2) in which there is reference already to an advocacy of the divine Spirit for man in the here and now of his earthly life (→ 810, 20-30).99 But the idea of the Spirit as παράκλητος is not unfamiliar to the rest of the NT even if the word is not used. Paul is aware that as the believer wrestles in prayer for assurance of the consummation of salvation the Spirit comes to aid him in his weakness and represents him before God by the babbling of glossolalia (R. 8:26 f.; → I, 376, 4 ff., συναντιλαμβάνω → έντυγχάνω, ὑπερεντυγχάνω). Jesus promised His disciples that when they had to give an account before earthly powers the Spirit would speak for them at the decisive moment, Mk. 13:11 and par. The picture of the intercessory Jesus in the Synoptic and Johannine tradition (Lk. 13:6-9; 22:32: [23:34]; Jn. 17) may be added to these testimonies to the advocacy of the Spirit in the world. It would seem, then, that the idea of a Paraclete in the earthly life of the disciples goes back ultimately to Jesus Himself

a. We are concerned only with a limited number of passages (Jn. 6:59; 7:14, 28, 35; 8:20, 28; 9:34; 14:26; 18:20; 1 Jn. 2:27; Rev. 2:14, 20). Some of these at least deserve brief treatment on their own, namely, those which speak more emphatically of teaching by God or by the Spirit. The rest fall essentially under the category of what we have already said concerning the διδάσκειν of Jesus, irrespective of the special content of the teaching of Jesus in them (Jn. 6:59; 7:14, 28, 35; 8:20; 18:20). A special place is occupied by Jn. 9:34, where διδάσκειν is used of the man born blind who, when he was healed, became a witness of Jesus. Indeed, it is used in relation to the opponents of Jesus, who would not accept instruction from him. Also to be numbered apart are the two passages in Rev. which speak of the teaching of Balaam and Jezebel in a way which has its model and presupposition in the OT use of לִמֵד/διδάσκειν (→

136). This leaves us with Jn. 8:28; 14:26 and 1 Jn. 2:27.

b. A characteristic of the use of διδάσκειν in Jn. 8:28; 14:26; 1 Jn. 2:27 is that it suggests in the first instance the presence of a direct inspiration or revelation. In Jn. 8:28 Jesus says with reference to His statements concerning Himself: ἀλλὰ καθώς ἐδίδαξέν με ὁ πατήρ, ταῦτα λαλῶ. In Jn. 14:26 Jesus holds out to the disciples the prospect of the παράκλητος, τὸ πνεῦμα τὸ ἅγιον, and promises: έκεῖνος ὑμᾶς διδάξει πάντα καὶ ύπομνήσει ύμας πάντα α είπον ὑμῖν ἐγώ. In 1 Jn. 2:27 the writer denies that his readers should need anyone to instruct them, because the xpîoµa which they have received διδάσκει them ... περὶ πάντων καὶ ἀληθές ἐστιν καὶ οὐκ ἔστιν ψεῦδος, καὶ καθώς ἐδίδαξεν ὑμᾶς, μένετε ἐν αὐτ $\hat{\omega}$. The → χρ \hat{i} σμα here is undoubtedly the Holy Spirit, so that this passage should be linked with Jn. 14:26. In any case it denotes the endowment with διδαχή from another world
